Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the general public and to members of the State of Arizona Board of Chiropractic Examiners that the Board will hold a regular meeting open to the public on the date and at the time indicated above.

When necessary, the Board may vote to go into Executive Session intermittently throughout the meeting for discussion and consultation for legal advice regarding any of the agenda items. A.R.S. § 38-431.03 (A)(3). The Board may also go into Executive Session, on items D - J on the agenda, where applicable, to review records exempt by law from public inspection, including the receipt and discussion of information or testimony that is specifically required to be maintained as confidential by state or federal law or to receive legal counsel. A.R.S. § 38-431.03 (A)(2). Executive Sessions are not open to the public.


The Board usually allows 5 minutes per person for public comment on any agenda item, however, depending on the issue presented, the Board Chairperson has the discretion to expand that time.
