Legislative Updates

On April 12, 2011, Governor Brewer signed <u>SB1037</u>, which amends A.R.S. 32-900, 32-921, 32-926, 32-931, 32-932, and 32-933. The change to A.R.S. 32-933 is important to all licensees on inactive status, as it alters the requirements for reinstatement to active status. Under the amended law, if a licensee applies for reinstatement within two years of their change to inactive status, they must prove to the Board that they have met the continuing education requirements set forth in statute and rule. The law will become effective July 20, 2011.

On April 19, 2011, Governor Brewer signed <u>SB1120</u>, which requires some of the business entities providing chiropractic services in Arizona to register with the Board. The law will become effective July 20, 2011.
