
The Board usually allows 2 minutes per person for public comment on any agenda item; however, depending on the issue presented, the Board Chairperson has the discretion to expand that time.

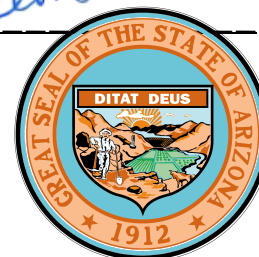
