One or more Board members may attend the meeting by telephone.

When necessary and in accordance with A.R.S. §38-431.03, the Board may vote to go into Executive Session intermittently throughout the meeting for the discussion or consultation for legal advice on any agenda item (A.R.S. §38-431.03(A)(3)) and to discuss records exempt by law from public inspection, including the receipt and discussion of information or testimony that is specifically required to be maintained as confidential by state or federal law on agenda items C, D, and E.

The Board usually allows 2 minutes per person for public comment on any agenda item, however, depending on the issue presented, the Board Chairperson has the discretion to expand that time.


