Privacy Policy

Effective Date: February 21, 2025

The Arizona Board of Chiropractic Examiners ("Board") is committed to protecting the privacy of visitors to our website, www.chiroboard.az.gov ("Website"). This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, and disclose information about our visitors.

Information We Collect

We collect the following types of information from our visitors:

- Personally Identifiable Information: This refers to information that can identify you as an individual, such as your name, email address, postal address, phone number, and date of birth. We collect this information when you voluntarily provide it to us, for example, when you create an account, apply for or renew a license, submit a complaint, or contact us with a question.
- Non-Personally Identifiable Information: This is information that does not directly identify you, such as your IP address, browser type, operating system, the pages you visit on our Website, and the links you click. We collect this information automatically as you browse our Website, and we may use cookies and other tracking technologies to collect this information.

How We Use Your Information

We use your information for the following purposes:

- To Provide and Improve Services: We use your information to operate and improve our Website, process license applications and renewals, respond to inquiries, and provide information about chiropractic practice in Arizona.
- Communication: We may use your information to communicate with you regarding your license, application status, respond to your inquiries, and provide important updates or notices.
- Legal Compliance: We may use and disclose your information to comply with applicable laws, regulations, legal processes, or government requests.





Disclosure of Your Information

We may disclose your information to the following third parties:

- Service Providers: We may share your information with third-party service
 providers who assist us with website hosting, data analysis, payment processing,
 and other essential functions. We have contracts with these providers requiring
 them to protect your information.
- Government Agencies: We may disclose your information to government agencies as required by law or legal process, including law enforcement agencies, courts, and other regulatory bodies.
- Other Third Parties: We may disclose your information to other third parties with your consent or as otherwise permitted by law.

Cookies and Tracking Technologies

We use cookies and other tracking technologies to collect non-personally identifiable information about your use of our Website. This information helps us analyze website traffic, improve our Website's functionality, and tailor content to your interests. You can set your browser to refuse cookies or alert you when cookies are being sent.

Security of Your Information

We take reasonable measures to protect your information from unauthorized access, use, or disclosure. However, no method of transmission over the Internet or method of electronic storage is 100% secure.
