### **Licensure by Endorsement**

**On April 1st, 2015, Arizona Governor Douglas A. Ducey signed into law SB1008. SB1008 established A.R.S. §32-922.03 Licensure by Endorsement; Requirements. Licensure by Endorsement allows for the licensure of qualified chiropractic physicians who would otherwise be eligible for application except they were licensed in another state prior to the establishment of the National Board of Chiropractic Examination Parts 3 and 4.**

**Statute and Rule require that individuals wishing to apply for Licensure by Endorsement meet the following qualifications:**

- **Holds an active license in another state or jurisdiction.**
- **Has actively practiced chiropractic in another state or jurisdiction.**
- **Has not had an adverse disciplinary action taken against a professional license.**
- **Passes the Arizona Board of Chiropractic Examiners Jurisprudence Examination.**
- **Not previously failed the Arizona State Chiropractic Examination.**
- **Has attained passing scores for Parts I and II of the examination given by the National Board of Chiropractic Examiners.**
- **Pays the Application fee of \$350.00.**
