
Proclamation


WHEREAS, James J. Badge, Doctor of Chiropractic successfully passed the Arizona State Chiropractic Licensing Examination administered by the Arizona Board of Chiropractic Examiners on the 8th day of July, 1973; and
WHEREAS, he was issued license number seven hundred and fifty-seven to practice in the chiropractic profession in the State of Arizona on the 4th day of August, 1973; and
WHEREAS, he was appointed to the Arizona Board of Chiropractic Examiners by Arizona Governor Bruce Babbitt on the 11th day of August, 1983; and
WHEREAS, he was elected Chairman of the Board of Chiropractic Examiners on the 13th day of December, 1983; and
WHEREAS, he was re-appointed to the Board by Governor Rose Mofford on the 21st day of July, 1988; and
WHEREAS, he served the Board until his replacement on the 12th day of August, 1993; and
WHEREAS, he was re-appointed to the Board by Governor Jane D. Hull on the 16th day of July, 1998; and
WHEREAS, he served the Board until his replacement on the 17th day of July, 2003; and
WHEREAS, he was appointed to the Board by Governor Janice K. Brewer on the 13th day of August, 2009; and
WHEREAS, he was elected Chairman of the Board of Chiropractic Examiners on the 17th day of May, 2012; and
WHEREAS, he was re-appointed to the Board by Arizona Governor Janice K. Brewer on the 1st day of July, 2014; and
WHEREAS, he served the Board until his passing on the 7th day of November, 2018; and
WHEREAS, he worked tirelessly to promote the Chiropractic Profession and dedicated many years of his exemplary career to this endeavor; and
WHEREAS, he was an integral part of the creation for the Part IV national examination and standards; and
WHEREAS, he was an active member and participant of the Federation of Chiropractic Licensing Boards, the National Board of Chiropractic Examiners, where he served in many positions including President, the International Board of Chiropractic Examiners, where he served as the first president, and the Arizona Association of Chiropractic, where he served as the first Co-President; and
WHEREAS, The Board of Chiropractic Examiners is proud to recognize an individual that dedicated his life to the service of the State of Arizona and the Chiropractic Profession.


